Life On Life, laboring in the lives of a few is God's master plan for making mature and equipped followers of Christ.

-1 Thes 2:8 "We share w/you not only the gospel but our very lives"

1. Life-on-Life Missional Discipleship is defined as:
"Laboring in the lives of a few with the intention of imparting one's life and God's truth in such a way as to see them become mature and equipped followers of Christ, committed to doing the same in the lives of others."
2. Life-on-Life Missional Discipleship requires:
 1. a qualified leader,
 2. a faithful few, willing to follow,
 3. intentionality regarding making mature and equipped followers of Christ, and
 4. doing the right things to make mature and equipped followers of Christ.

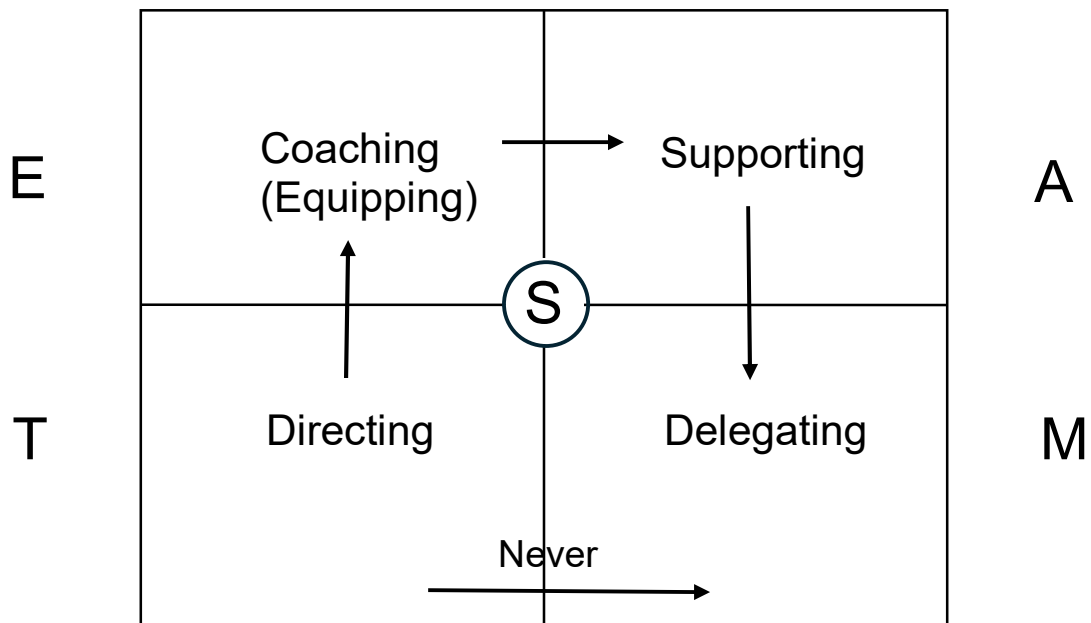
